And Bill Rivard, our VP of Operations will be with us 20 years in November to begin our celebrations as we move into 25 years of Circle of Excellence in travel!

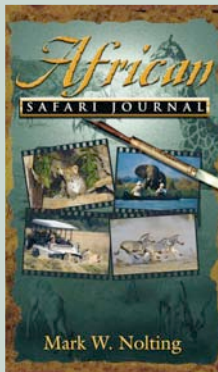
