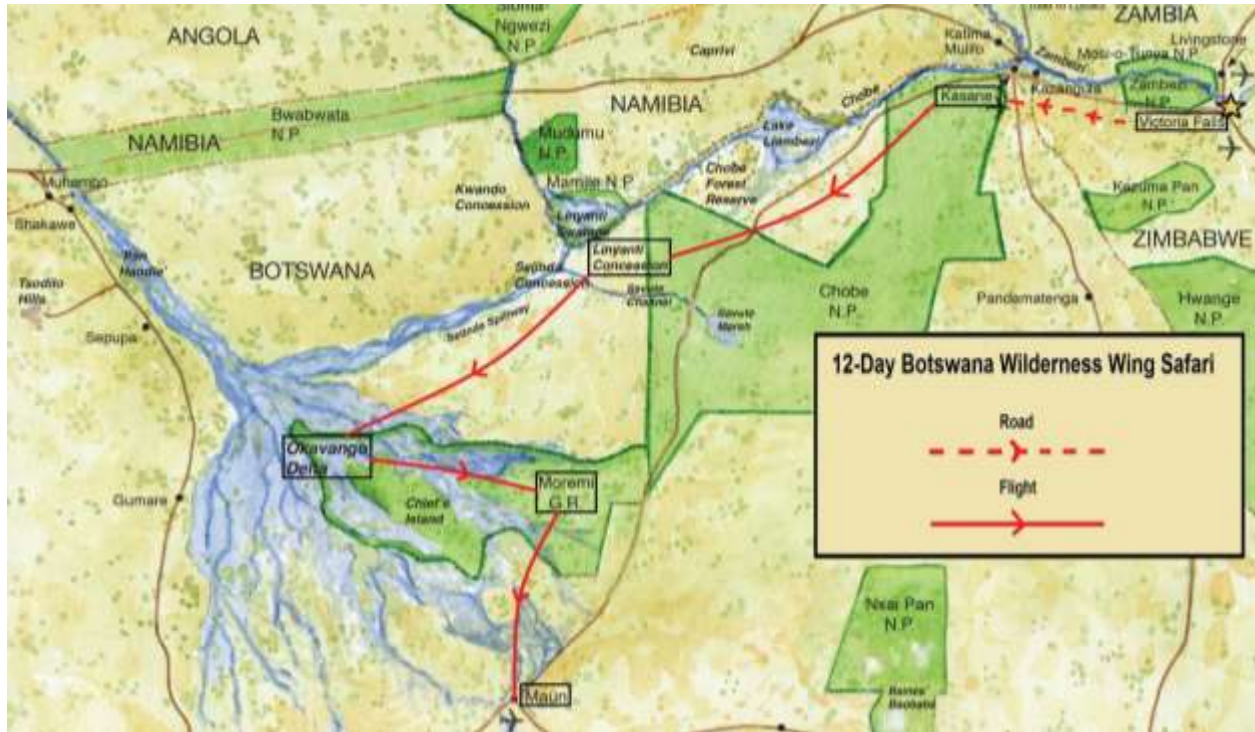

- 1) An extra night at Ilala Lodge can be added - from \$275.00 per person/sharing. Please note other hotels can be substituted such as Elephant Camp, Victoria Falls Hotel and Victoria Falls Safari Club.
- 2) Single Supplement. Please inquire with your Safari Consultant if traveling solo.
- 3) We can substitute a lodge in Chobe (Chobe Game Lodge, Chobe Chilwero, Muchenje) for camps in Linyanti.
- 4) For the more active persons, you may want to consider "**camping out**". In order to do this you need to spend 3 nights at the relative camp as the "camp out" becomes the middle night. You can either add a night to the program or only visit 2 camps and spend 3 nights in each.
  - a) Tubu, Little Tubu, Savuti and DumaTau allow you to spend a night sleeping in their raised hide (weather permitting).
