### **Trip Report:**

Our safari was really pretty fantastic. We had great photographic opportunities. We saw the big five in the first day and one half and then had many good sightings on the other days. Of the 13 half day safari drives in MalaMala we had only one drive that was fairly quiet. The rest were great. The one problem at MalaMala was that the area is covered in large part in rather thick brush making photography more challenging than say at the more open areas at Mashatu. On the other hand the foliage was starting to change and that added to the scenery.

The hides in Mashatu were spectacular for photography and just seeing some of the animals during our use on three half days. Ruth, who was our photography guide, was great. All our drives there were productive.

All the arrangements worked out flawlessly which we very much appreciated. We were glad that, with your help, we picked two good places to visit.
