


TOURS OF VICTORIA FALLS

Tour of the Falls and Chief Mukuni's Village

Clients are accompanied by an experienced guide, who after a brief history and explanation of the Falls escorts them through the winding paths pointing out and elaborating on points of interest. They are also given information on the plants, birds and other wildlife that they come across.

After the tour of the falls, clients are taken to the traditional village. They will learn about the history of how the tribe began and how they have evolved. There are local people in the village performing traditional skills such as carving, basket weaving and even cooking. Clients will then have the opportunity to shop in the attached market and Curio shops for souvenirs and gifts.

SUNSET CRUISES ON THE ZAMBEZI RIVER

Lunch or Sundowner Cruises on the Zambezi River

While cruising UPSTREAM along the Zambezi River in a relaxing atmosphere, a variety of game can be seen including hippos, crocs, elephants and even rhino. The sunset cruises have more of a party feeling and include finger snacks, beer, wine, and soft drinks. There are great opportunities for photos against the spectacular sunset.

Sundowner cruises are included in the rate at lodges such as Thorntree, Toka Leya and Tongabezi

ADRENALIN ACTIVITIES

"Flight of the Angels" by helicopter

These flights depart throughout the day. Clients are collected from their hotels before their flight time. When they arrive at the Heli-Pad, they are given a brief safety talk and an explanation of the route their flight will take. Clients are flown over the Falls and surrounding areas which enables them to take amazing photos from a unique view point. We suggest booking in the morning, the earlier the better!

13 minutes (\$200.00 per person) / 30 minutes (\$370.00 per person) *

- **A passenger safety charge (introduced by the Zambian Civil Aviation Authority) will be collected at the helipad \$6.00 per person

Whitewater Rafting

Enjoy a day of white-water rafting (US\$10.00 park fee pay direct in cash – not included in trip cost). There is a courtesy transfer service from all the main hotels. WWR departs daily. Tea, coffee and biscuits are served in the morning. A guide will give a briefing and safety talk before departing for the gorge. Please be warned that there is a very steep and long climb out of the gorge at the end of the day, approx. 750 feet to the top and requires a reasonable degree of fitness. The morning is spent riding the rapids before stopping for a light lunch. If you are booked during 'low water' (August-January), you will continue rafting in the afternoon.

Approximately Feb-Jul - high water / Aug-Jan - low water \$175.00 per person / \$190.00 per person

* Rate is subject to increase if less than 4 people on departure (excludes \$10.00 park fee)





Bunjee Jump - off Victoria Falls Bridge

Age limit: 14 years (children under the age of 18 need an indemnity form signed by their parent.) Weight limit: minimum 40kgs, maximum 140kgs.

On arrival at the registration area, clients are screened, weighed and registered for the jump. Prior to jumping, clients are briefed individually. This includes: How the harness system works, the final jump procedure to be followed on the platform, what to expect during the jump and the recovery procedure. Victoria Falls Bridge is within walking distance from the main hotels, however transfers can be arranged.

Half-Day Adrenalin Rush

This adrenalin rush includes Abseil, Gorge Swing and Zip Line:

- * **Abseiling** (Rappelling) ~ After a short lesson, you will get buckled into your gear and step over the canyon walls of the Batoka Gorge and rappel down the side. Trained guides will be watching you all the way and a safety rope is controlled by the guide at the bottom.
- * Gorge Swing ~ The swing is done using two 65 meter static line climbing rope attached to a 10 ton safe working load cable by a steel clamp. A 1m-bungi cord is positioned on the clamp to provide the swinger with a smoother ride and more comfortable swing. Swingers remain in a seated position throughout the recovery and can enjoy the view of both the falls and the bridge.

Zip Line – A cable is spanned across the gorge 135m long and 75m above the ground. You are harnessed in a sitting position and run off the edge cliff and soar across the gorge on a cable.

Minimum age is 14, under 18 years old requires signed parental consent Cost: \$190.00 per person (does not include park fees or transfers)





<u>Livingstone Island Lunch</u> (Subject to water levels – please check availability)

Once you've pulled back from the edge of the falls, enjoy an exclusive brunch, champagne lunch or a high tea on Livingstone Island. David Livingstone first viewed the falls from this island, now named in his honor, so can you!

2.5 hours (\$225.00 pp)

Morning Breezers (Subject to water levels – please check availability)

Transfer to Livingstone, Zambia for a fun excursion that takes you to the edge of Victoria Falls. Depart by a small jet boat as your guide navigates around the islands above the falls to Livingstone Island. Once on the island you walk to where the falls begin and then it's into the water and you swim across to the rocks located directly above the falls.

Return to Livingstone Island for snacks and drinks before the boat ride back to the dock.

Aug-Dec - bathing suits and aqua socks are recommended.7:30am, 9:00am or 10:30am departures from the Livingstone hotel dock.\$135.00 per person











ANIMAL & GAME VIEWING OPTIONS

Elephant Interaction

The adventure begins at the Zambezi Elephant Trails, located 10 km from Livingstone. You will have a welcome briefing and will be given an education presentation on the sanctuary and the individual elephants. At this time a selection of the elephants are brought out and you are able to feed them treats (you remain safely behind a wooden barrier). You will then venture out into the bush to spend time walking with the elephant.

Children must be 10 years or older. A guardian must accompany all children under 16 and a guardian must sign an indemnity form for all persons under 18.

\$100.00 per child or adult – 1.5 hours (min 4)

Excludes transfers + park fees.



The adventure begins with a boat cruise upriver from Victoria Falls. Once you arrive the Elephant Sanctuary you have the opportunity to touch the elephants, feed them and pose for photos with them. Continue to the deck which is suspended over the Zambezi River where guests will enjoy a champagne cocktail before dining on the prix fixe menu. Described as "bush gourmet cuisine", the meal highlights locally sourced fresh ingredients. A return boat ride back to the Livingstone pier ends your tour. Children must be 10 years or older.

Select from Lunch (departs 10:00am) or Dinner (departs 3:15pm)

Lunch or Dinner - Based on minimum 3 people - \$280.00* per child or adult

Excludes park fees \$10. Includes roundtrip boat transfers, meal and local drinks (wine, beer and soda)

Mosi-oa-Tunya National Park

Mosi-oa-Tunya, translating to the "Smoke that Thunders", is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and has a portion of the mighty Victoria Falls within it. The wildlife park includes Angolan giraffe, zebra, warthog, sable, buffalo and impala. The highlight is viewing the southern white rhinos where a small population live under the watchful eye of park rangers.

Game drives are conducted in open vehicles and offered in the morning and afternoon (approx. 2 hrs long)

Cost: \$65.00 per person (additional \$10 park fees payable directly)

Rhino Walk – Take a safari vehicle through the park to where the park rangers and rhinos are located. You will receive a briefing and proceed to walk near the rhino (from a safe distance) and photograph the rhinos. Offered in the morning or late afternoon.

Cost: \$145.00 per person (additional \$10 park fees payable directly)

Horse-riding

Horse riding trails from a bush farm property which overlooks the Zambezi River (located about 6 km's up stream from River Club). The rides are either 2 hours or half-day with lunch. Elephant, buffalo and kudu are sometimes seen in this area, but are not guaranteed. You also ride along the river.

2 hrs US\$90.00 pp (min 2) / Half-day US\$125.00 pp (min 2 – experienced riders only, \$10 park fees additional)







SPECIALIST TOURING

Royal Livingstone Express

The Royal Livingstone Express is a nostalgic rail experience. You are collected from your hotel and transferred to the vintage first class lounge. The train departs at 5:45pm and travels towards Mosi-oa-Tunya National Park at which time you can game view from the comfort of the luxurious rail car. As darkness falls, you are invited to one of the two dining cars which hold a capacity of 92 guests and served a gourmet 6-course meal. The train returns to the station at approximately 9:30pm at which time you are transferred back to your hotel.

\$225.00 per person including transfers, dinner and wine, beer and soft drinks.

(Rate is based on pick-up from Sun International Hotel; other hotels will require additional transfer costs.)

<u>Lunar Rainbow Tour</u> (also known as moonbow) is a rainbow against the backdrop of the night sky. Because Victoria Falls has a constant rainbow in the daytime, the incredible volume of mist produced is enough to create a lunar rainbow visible during a full moon. Join your group which is led by a National Park guide to view this unique site.



- * This tour can operate from the Zambia side of the falls during Mar-Sep but from Oct-Feb, you must transfer across border to Zimbabwe (visa fees applicable).

LUSAKA TOURING

Lusaka City Day Tour

You will be collected from your hotel at 08:00 and embark on your Lusaka City Day Tour.

During this tour you will drive along one of the oldest roads in Lusaka, Great East Road, past the Parliament buildings and the University of Zambia before heading to Cairo Road and the CBD of Lusaka.

Welcome to the CBD! The hustle and bustle of Lusaka, here you will drive past the historical buildings of Lusaka, and see what life is like in the center of town.

On your way back in, you'll be driven down Independence Avenue which takes you past State House, the Zambian Supreme Court, the Cathedral of the Holy Cross, and our Freedom Statue which symbolizes the end of colonialism in Zambia.

On the same road we have Dr Kenneth Kuanda's Chilenge House (the first president of Zambia), Lusaka Museum and Embassy Park, if you are interested there are guides at each location who can give you a quick tour of the places.

Depending on time, and what your interests are, great options available in the Lusaka City Tour are:

Kabwata Market: a cultural village that has several little knickknacks and souvenirs from all corners of Zambia – and a great opportunity to take some things back home with you!

Chikumbuso Project: a community project which helps women and orphans to become educated as well as develop various skills to help them with the future.

Lusaka Elephant Nursery: Elephants that are orphaned in the wild, are rescued and rehabilitated by Game Rangers International (a non-governmental organization based in Zambia). This is the first elephant orphanage in Southern Africa and only one of a few on the continent. Once the elephants are old enough to be weened from their milk, they are transferred to Kafue National Park and eventually back in to the wild.

The viewing time at the orphanage happens daily at 12h00.

Lusaka Collective: the name is as it suggests, they are a collective of Zambian artisans. This shop has some stunning pieces, all proudly Zambian and great novelties to take back.

Art Galleries: a few great galleries around Lusaka to see are the Lechwe Trust, 37D Gallery and Henry Tiyali.

Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant before returning to your hotel in the afternoon.
