All visa information is provided in good faith and is believed to be correct; however, requirements/recommendations can change at very short notice. Visa requirements may vary depending on Passport Nationality and your originating country. We keep our visa information up-to-date as much as possible, but rules do change so it is very important that you also check with your local embassy.

USA and Canadian citizens can obtain their visas where required on arrival at the airport/border crossing for most of the above listed countries for a fee paid in US\$ cash. Please contact us or the local embassy for the cost of the visa, links to the online eVISA sites or for the visa requirements if you are travelling on another nationality of passport. **(Passports must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your intended stay and contain sufficient blank VISA pages.)**

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VISA AND VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS (cont'd)

NOTES:

- **ANTI-MALARIA** – Some form of anti-malaria medication is **STRONGLY URGED**. Anti-Malaria is a tablet not a vaccination and needs a prescription.
- **OPTIONAL VACCINATIONS** - Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, Typhoid, Tetanus, Polio and Meningitis
- **YELLOW FEVER** – Some countries require **all travelers** to show proof of yellow fever vaccination (eg. Uganda) before they can enter the country.

Other countries only require proof of vaccination **if travelers have been in a risk area**, so if you are visiting multiple countries in East Africa, the order of travel may be important.

If travelling from endemic zones (ie. Africa, South America, Central America or Asia), proof of vaccination will also be required.

Proof of vaccination is not valid until 10 days after you get the vaccine, so plan to get the vaccine early if you need it.
